I did that for 7 years and then low and behold, this Lieblinger rebel, from way back, became President!!! Man, how things changed since I was 5. Currently I am Vice President again, under President, Rick Stumpf, and our Club is still very strong, bringing in new members almost every month...I always say, "Life changes on a dime". It's all in your head. I wish my dad were still here to see how I changed. He would be proud!

If you want your children and grandchildren to enjoy and embrace this Club, and its rock-solid heritage, then you must make up your mind to do something positive about that. They will look up to you one day and say "Thank you" for something they would not have without your commitment. Come to our next meeting, September 10th, and bring your family...you will enjoy it!!
