The set-up for the hall on the day of the Kirchweih will begin at 1:00 pm. The Auction bidding rules were discussed, and members voted with a show of hands to revert to the 10 cent bidding rules unless members in the audience bid.

The Christmas Party was discussed so that a Flyer can be prepared and printed and put on the table at the Kirchweih and sent out with the October newsletter.

The price of the dinner for members is \$20.00 for adults (12 and over), \$10.00 for children (11-3), and children under 3 free. The price for non-members is \$40.00 for adults (12 and over) and \$20.00 for children (11-3) and children under 3 free.
